CALL FOR PAPERS

The standard and quality papers will be published in conference proceedings, Nepalese Journal of Management, Nepalese Journal of Finance, Nepalese Journal of Business and Nepalese Journal of Economics.

Manuscripts should follow APA style while preparing the papers.

Registration is limited to 20 foreign delegates and the rest is reserved for the Nepalese research scholars, faculties, practitioners and students. About 400 participants are expected to participate in this conference.
