

Uniglobe College: Scholarship Guidelines

Uniglobe College has approved the following guidelines for scholarships which are applicable for Bachelors and Masters levels all the academic programs running at the college.

1. Uniglobe College adopts the scholarship rules of the Pokhara University. It has been providing scholarships as Pokhara University, Scholarship Niyamawali 2065. The University provides 10% of total approved quota in Bachelors and Masters Level programs. It is 100% free scholarship in tuition and any other fees charged by the college and the university itself.
2. The types of scholarships are:
 - a. Academically meritorious/intellectual scholarship
 - b. Open scholarship
 - c. Lekhanath scholarship
 - d. Dalit scholarship
 - e. Janjaati scholarship
 - f. Durgam scholarship
 - g. Apanga, Shahid and Jana-aandolan victim scholarship
 - h. Faculty staff scholarship
 - i. Madheshi community scholarship
3. At present Uniglobe College is providing scholarship under Pokhara University regulations to 15 (fifteen) students in bachelors level and 9 (nine) students in Masters level which is total of 24 (twenty four) in each intake.
4. Besides, Pokhara University regulated scholarships, Uniglobe College also provides partial scholarships to the students in Bachelors and Masters level as following:
 - a. Merit based scholarship to topper students in entrance and interview with past academic performance the college provides 30% waiver/scholarship in tuition fee of the college. BBA-3, BBA (Finance)-1, BCSIT-1, MBA (Finance)-2, MBA-1
 - b. Merit based scholarship to second topper students in entrance and interview with past academic performance the college provides 25% waiver/scholarship in tuition fee of the college. BBA-3, BBA (Finance)-1, BCSIT-1, MBA (Finance)-2, MBA-1
 - c. Merit based scholarship to third topper students in entrance and interview with past academic performance the college provides 20% waiver/scholarship in tuition fee of the college. BBA-3, BBA (Finance)-1, BCSIT-1, MBA (Finance)-2, MBA-1:

- d. Financially poor from remote area with recommendation from local government the college provides 50% waiver/scholarship in tuition fee of the college. BBA or BBA (Finance)-1, BCSIT-1, MBA (Finance) or MBA-1
- e. Financially poor with recommendation from local government the college provides 30% waiver/scholarship in tuition fee of the college. BBA-1 or BBA (Finance)-1, MBA (Finance) or MBA-1
- f. Financially poor and Madheshi/Janajaati/Dalit/Disable scholarship with valid documents the college provides 30% waiver/scholarship in tuition fee of the college. Bachelor level-3, Masters-2
- g. Faculty/Staff members close relatives the college provides 25% waiver/scholarship in tuition fee of the college. Bachelor level-3, Masters-2
- h. Graduates from Uniglobe College and its associated institutions the college provides 20% waiver/scholarship in tuition fee of the college.
- i. Students recommended by Uniglobe students/alumni the college provides 10% waiver/scholarship in tuition fee of the college.
